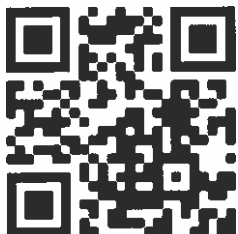

Parents, caregivers, and their children can learn, grow and connect by:

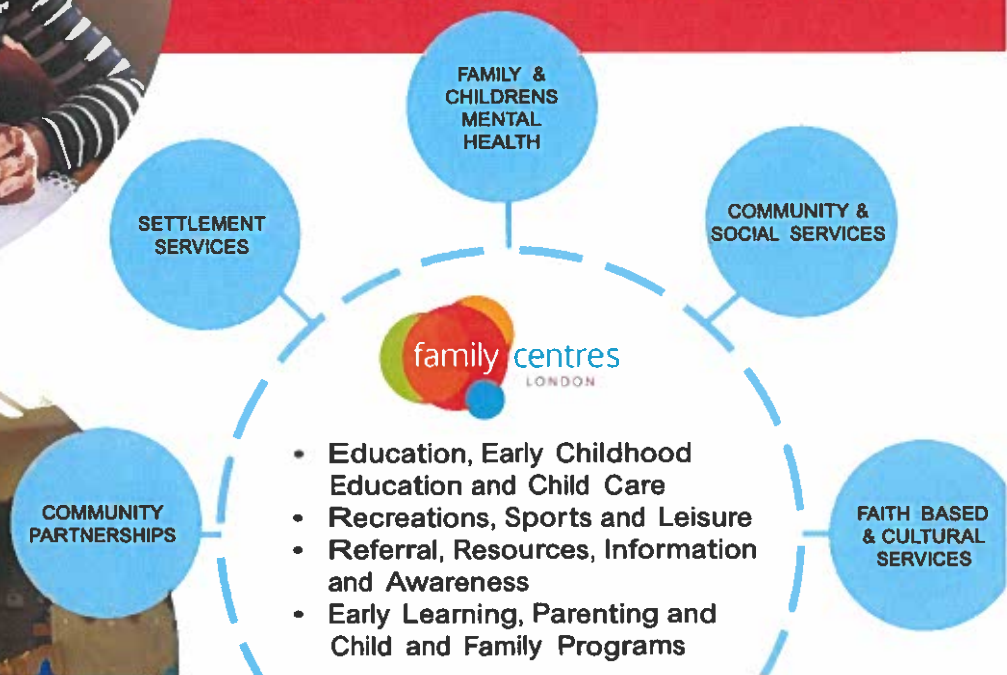
- Participating in fun activities
