Welcome to the Kindergarten Program!

You can expect that throughout the day, your child will be involved in spontaneous play as well as more structured play-based learning. As children play, they learn about the world around them and how it works, about other people, and about themselves. The Teachers and Early Childhood Educators have carefully organized the full day for your child, keeping in mind that young children will require adequate nutrition breaks and quiet opportunities. Balanced Day

Schools using the balanced school day schedule balance the learning periods and nutrition periods more evenly during the school day. This tends to minimize disruptions and provides for a more balanced intake of food. Total instruction time remains the same.

11:50-1:30	Second Learning Block
1:30-2:10	Second Nutrition Break (eat/outside)
2:10-3:30	Third Learning Block

Please send extra socks and mitts in case of wet feet and hands. It is also a good idea to have a change of clothes kept here at the school for quick and easy changes if needed.

Attendance

The safety of our students is very important to us at Dunwich-Dutton PS. When your child is not able to attend school for whatever the reason, including illness, appointments, bus cancellations, etc. please report through the School Messenger app (found on the App Store or Google Play), by calling School Messenger at 1-844-305-3756, or by going online at www.tvdsb.ca/schoolmessenger. Safe arrival calls will be made to parents/guardians of absent students if we have not received communication as to their absence. If your child needs to leave school early for an appointment you can call the office prior to your arrival to pick them. If returning to school the same day, please have them come to the office to sign back in.



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Signing In/Out

Parents are reminded to have their student(s) please stop in the office to sign in and receive a late slip to present to the classroom teacher if they arrive after 9:00 am. This procedure is for the safety of the students. To support the education of our students, we wish to keep class interruptions to a minimum. You can help us by making arrangements prior to the school day for your child sending a note or email to your student's teacher when you need to pick him/her up for appointments. You can drop off forgotten lunches, schoolwork or other items at the office by ringing the bell at the front doors.

Medication

The Thames Valley District School Board has a medication policy. If it becomes necessary for your child to take prescription medication at school, please call the school in advance. The office provides a form requiring you to outline the details of the administration of the medication. **This form must be completed and signed by the parent/guardian and a physician before we can administer any medication.**

Transportation

Registration is mandatory and will be available online at www.mybigyellowbus.ca in June 2023. Some students will be eligible to have bus transportation to and from the school. Please keep in mind that only students who qualify for transportation will be allowed to take the bus.

Bus Cancellations and Inclement Weather

Check www.mybigyellowbus.ca for details on bus cancellations. When buses are cancelled, the school remains open. Please report to the SchoolMessenger system if you choose to keep your child at home, even if they are bussed. If buses are cancelled, you are welcome to drop off your child if you feel that the roads are safe for you to drive. We simply ask that you are available to pick up your child at 3:30 pm dismissal. In the case of school closures, this will be posted on the TVDSB website.
